Dr. Malinda S. Smith, the Chair of the Advisory Committee on Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Decolonization, is the inaugural Vice Provost (Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion), a Professor of Political Science, and a Fellow of the Pierre Elliott Trudeau Foundation at the University of Calgary. Dr. Smith previously served as the Vice-President (Equity Issues) for the Federation for the Humanities and Social Sciences.

Dr. Smith is a member of the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council, Statistics Canada's Advisory Committee on Ethnocultural and Immigration Statistics and its working group on Black communities in Canada; the National Dialogues and Action's Inter-Institutional Advisory Committee; and the BlackNorth Initiative's Education Committee. Dr. Smith advised on the drafting of the Tri-Agency's Dimensions EDI Charter, and served on the Canada Research Chairs Program's Advisory Committee on EDI Policy (2018-21), where she also chaired the CRCP's EDI Review Panel (2019-2020).

Dr. Smith is co-editor of *Nuances of Blackness in the Canadian Academy* (forthcoming, UofT 2021) and co-author of *The Equity Myth: Racialization and Indigeneity at Canadian Universities* (UBC Press, 2017), and co-editor, States of Race: Critical Race Feminism for the 21st Century (BTL 2010). She is the founder of The Diversity Gap Canada, and a columnist for *University Affairs Magazine*.
