What are the Scholarly Book Awards

- The Scholarly Book Awards, formally the Awards to Scholarly Publications Program (ASPP), provides financial support for the publication of scholarly books in the humanities and social sciences that make a significant contribution to knowledge and scholarship
- The program does not have deadlines and receives applications continuously throughout the year

Why you should join

- If you enjoy seeing a wide variety of cutting-edge research in your discipline, then you will enjoy the work of the Scholarly Book Awards Publications Committee

What you will do

- This a volunteer position with a term of office of 3 years, for up to two terms
- You can expect to review about 12 to 15 applications per year, this varies by discipline and by year
- **You are not required to read the entire manuscripts**
- Your focus will be on the peer review reports submitted with the application and the author's response to those reports

Who can join

- We are looking for committee members who read English, French or both
- Committee members should have authored at least one scholarly book in their subject area
