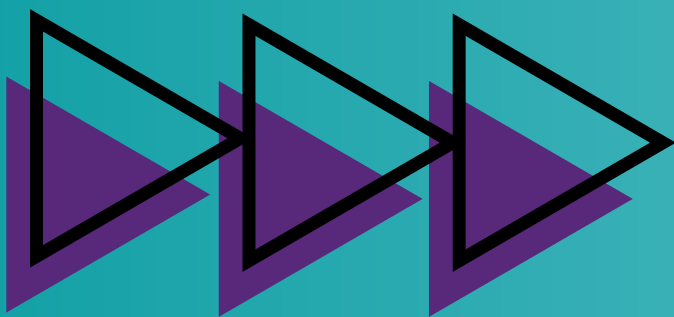

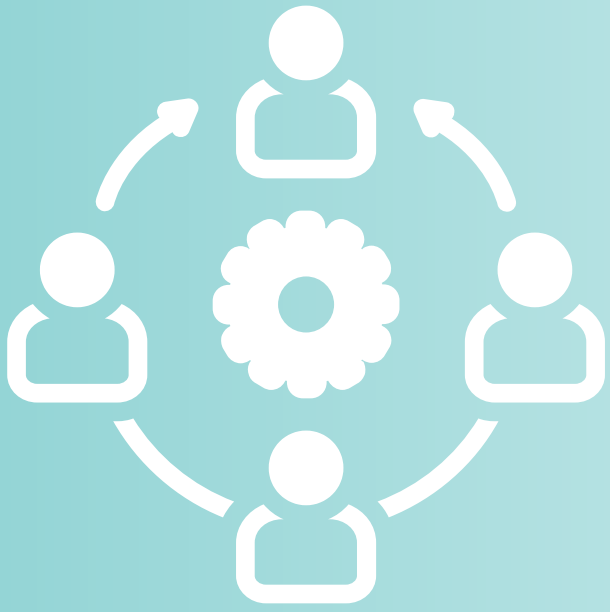

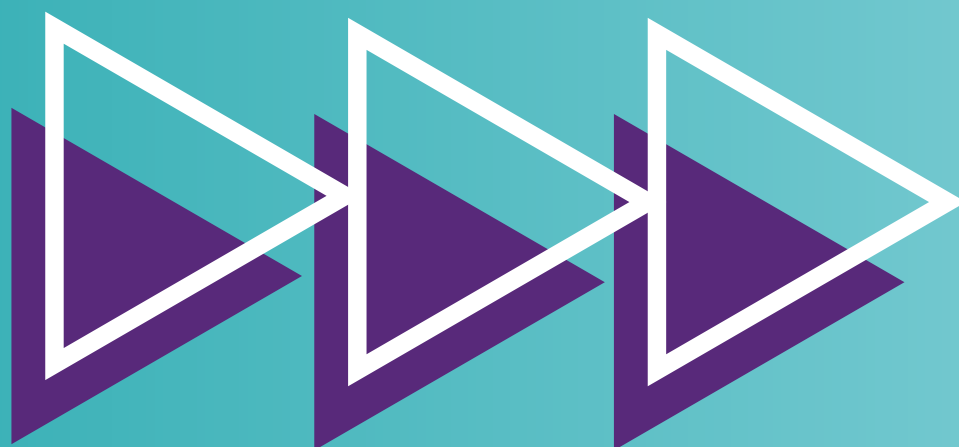


## Equip citizens for informed and thoughtful public participation
